

#### 1 Introduction

The Lamp Housing 100 is designed for the use of light sources of up to 100W.

It is available in two variants: Lamp Housing 100 with simple centring facility

Lamp Housing 100 Z with complete centring device for the reflector and lamp.

A pre-centred 12v 60W or 12v 100W low-voltage filament lamp is used in the Lamp Housing 100 (horizontal and vertical centration).

The Lamp Housing 100 Z is suitable for the use of gas discharge lamps and therefore has a reflector with centring device for the production of a secondary image of the filament. The following light sources can be used:

for Lamp Housing 100 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp 12v 60W/100W filament lamp OSRAM spectrum lamps 100W deuterium lamps

for Lamp Housing 100 Z 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp 50W ultra-high-pressure mercury lamp 100W ultra-high-pressure mercury lamp 45W high-pressure mercury lamp (St 48) 75W high-pressure xenon lamp

The condenser of the Lamp Housing 100 and 100 Z is interchangeable.

# 2 Technical description






Fig. 1 Lamp Housing 100

- 8 Attachment ring and bayonet lock
- 9 Reflector for the use of the 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp




Fig. 4 Filter set F

### 3 Lamp Housing 100

#### 3 Inserting the pre-centred 12v 60W or 12v 100W low-voltage filament lamp





Fig. 5 Inserting the 12v 60W or 100W filament lamp in the lamp mount

- 19 Grub screw for arresting the baseplate for the 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp





Fig. 7 Regulating transformer for the 12v 60W/100W lamp

For shipment, lamp mount 1.1\* and baseplate 1.10 are accommodated in the lamp housing. Release mount 1.1 and remove it from the lamp housing. Insert the filament lamp with the wide locating strip 5.16 in the aperture 5.17. slightly press it downwards, and lock it by a clockwise turn. Push the pre-centred lamp mount with lamp into the attachment fitting 6.2 in the back of the lamp housing as far as possible, and connect it to the transformer. Optimum illumination is obtained by rotation of the focusing knob 1.4 for the lamp condenser and simultaneous observation through the eyepiece tube, until the rear focal plane of the objective is evenly illuminated.

#### 312 Adjusting the sliding sleeve for the 60W and 100W filament lamp

- 22 Sliding sleeve




Fig. 9 Position of the sliding sleeve 22 when the 100W lamp is used

Release grub screw 8.20 by three anticlockwise turns. Push the sliding sleeve 8.22 up to the front recess 8.21 of the guide groove. Tighten the screw. The filament of the lamp is now correctly adjusted for the 100W lamp (Fig. 9).

# 32 Inserting the 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp in the Lamp Housing 100





Fig. 10 Inserting the 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp 23 Tungsten halogen lamp

Fg. 11 Lamp housing, open, with 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp



During shipment lamp mount 11.24 and reflector 11.9 are accommodated in the lamp housing.

Remove the lateral lid. Move condenser 11.25 into the front-most position. Remove the lamp mount. Insert the lamp with protective cover in the socket of the mount. Remove the protective cover only after insertion. Insert and secure the lamp mount with lamp, close the lamp housing. Connect it to transformer.



#### 33 Adjusting the 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp in the Lamp Housing 100

Remove the filters and diffusion disc from the filter slot 1.7. Completely open the field diaphragm. Place the adjustment disc on the dustglass of the microscope.




Rotate knob 5 for the vertical adjustment as far as it will go in the direction of the arrow.



Focus the reflected image of the lamp filament by moving the reflector 1.9 and secure it with the grub screw 11.18. Form an image of the lamp filament and its mirror image on the adjustment disc by rotating knob 13.4. Move the image of the lamp filament and its mirror image into the centre by rotating knob 13.6.

Rotate knob 13.5 for the vertical adjustment of the lamp until the image of the filament and the mirror image marginally overlap.

After insertion of the diffusing disc and removal of the adjustment disc rotate the focusing knob 13.4 for the lamp condenser, simultaneously observing through the eyepiece tube, until the rear focal plane of the objective is evenly illuminated.


#### 34 Replacing the tungsten filament lamp by the low-voltage lamp

For the replacement of the tungsten halogen lamp by the 12v 60W filament lamp open the lamp housing, release the grub screw 11.19 and pull out the mount with tungsten halogen lamp downwards. Insert baseplate 1.10 and

secure it with the grub screw 11.19. Close the lamp housing.

Release the grub screw 11.18, pull out reflector 11.9 towards the rear and insert the lamp mount with low-voltage lamp as far as it will go. Connect it to the transformer.

#### 41 Inserting the 50W ultra-high-pressure mercury lamp




Fig. 15 Mount for 50W ultra-high-pressure mercury lamp




Fig. 18 Lamp Housing 100 Z open

For shipment, the lamp mount 18.24 is inserted in the Lamp Housing 100 Z. Open lamp housing, release grub screw 18.19 and pull the mount out downwards. Insert the lamp between clamping jaws 15.26 of the flexible current lead 15.28 and clamp it with the knurled screw 15.27. Release grub screw 15.29 in the mount and insert the remaining free mount of the lamp bearing lettering. Tighten grub screw 16.29.


Move the condenser 18.25 into the frontmost position (in the direction of the attachment fitting). Insert lamp mount 18.24 with lamp 18.31 into the lamp housing from below as far as it will go. The recess 15.30 in the lamp mount must face the grub screw 18.19, which must now be tightened.

Close the lamp housing and connect it to the power unit.

# 42 Centring the 50W ultra-high-pressure mercury lamp


Remove the filters from the slot 1.7. Completely open the field diaphragm in the microscope. Insert grey filter in the beam to reduce the light intensity. Place the adjustment disc on the dustglass of the microscope.

Image of the lamp



Adjust the knurled knob 1.4 for the condenser until a sharp image of the discharge arc is formed on the adjustment disc. Rotate knob 18.5 for the vertical adjustment until the image of the discharge arc is moved to the correct level according to the illustration. Rotate knob 1.6 for the horizontal adjustment until the image of the arc appears between the two inner circles of the adjustment disc.

Image of the lamp and its mirror image



Adjust focusing knob 18.14 for the adjustment of the concave mirror in the direction of the optical axis until a sharp mirror image is formed of the discharge arc. Rotate knob 18.13 for the vertical adjustment until the mirror image is at the same level as the image of the discharge arc. Actuate the knob 18,15 for the lateral adjustment, until both images (discharge arc and mirror image) are side by side. After the discharge are image and the mirror image have been positioned side by side remove the adjustment dies from the dustglass of the microscope.

The condenser 1.4 must now be adjusted, with simultaneous observation through the eyepiece tube, until the rear focal plane of the objective is

evenly illuminated. Remove the grey filter from the beam and turn the diffusing disc in.






Fig. 19 Mount of the 100W mercury lamp





Fig. 22 Lamp Housing 100 Z open with 100W mercury lamp

# 44 Inserting the 75W high-pressure xenon lamp Wear protective goggles and gloves (danger of explosion)

The plastic protective body must not yet be removed. Even when cold, the high-pressure xenon lamp is under pressure.




Fig. 27 Lamp Housing 100 Z open, with the 75W xenon lamp




Fig. 28 Power unit for the 100W mercury lamp and the 75W xenon lamp

### 45 Centring the 75W high-pressure xenon lamp and the 100W ultrahigh-pressure mercury lamp


Remove the filters from the filter slot. Completely open the field diaphragm in the microscope. Insert grey filter in the beam to reduce the light intensity. Place the adjustment disc on the dustglass of the microscope.

Image of the lamp



Adjust the condenser with the knurled knob 1.4 until a sharp image is formed of the cathode focal spot on the adjustment disc. Rotate the knob 22,5 for the vertical adjustment until the image of the focal spot is below the middle circle of the adjustment disc. Rotate knob 1.6 for horizontal adjustment until the focal spot is brought into the centre according to the illustration.

#### Image of the lamp and its mirror image



Adjust the focusing knob 22,14 for the adjustment of the concave mirror in the direction of the optical axis until a sharp image of the mirror image of the focal spot is formed. Rotate knob 22.13 for the vertical adjustment until the mirror image is located above the middle circle of the adjustment disc.

Actuate the knob 22.15 for lateral adjustment until the mirror image faces the image of the focal spot according to the illustration.

Now adjust the condenser, with simultaneous observation through the eyepiece tube, until the rear focal plane of the objective is evenly illuminated. Remove the grey filter, and the adjustment disc from the dustglass.

### 46 Centring the 12v 100W tungsten halogen lamp in the Lamp Housing 100 Z

The tungsten halogen lamp is inserted as described under Lamp Housing 100.

Remove any filters and the diffusion disc from the filter slot; completely open the field diaphragm. Place the adjustment disc on the dustglass.

#### Lamp image




Form a sharp image of the lamp filament on the adjustment disc with the focusing knob 1.4 for the condenser.

Move the image of the lamp filament below the middle circle of the adjustment disc by means of the vertical adjustment knob 1.5.

Rotate knob 1.6 for the horizontal adjustment of the lamp until the image of the lamp filament is in the centre of the adjustment disc.

#### Image of the lamp and ts mirror image



Form a sharp mirror image of the lamp filament with the focusing knob 22.14.

Move the mirror image laterally above the inner circle of the adjustment disc with knob 22.13.

Move the mirror image on top of the image of the lamp filament with knob 22.15. The image of the lamp filament and its mirror image must now be located in the centre of the adjustment disc.

Remove the adjustment disc from the dustglass. Insert the diffusion disc into the filter slot. Now adjust the condenser with knob 1.4, simultaneously observing the image through the eyepiece tube, until the rear focal plane of the objective is evenly illuminated.
